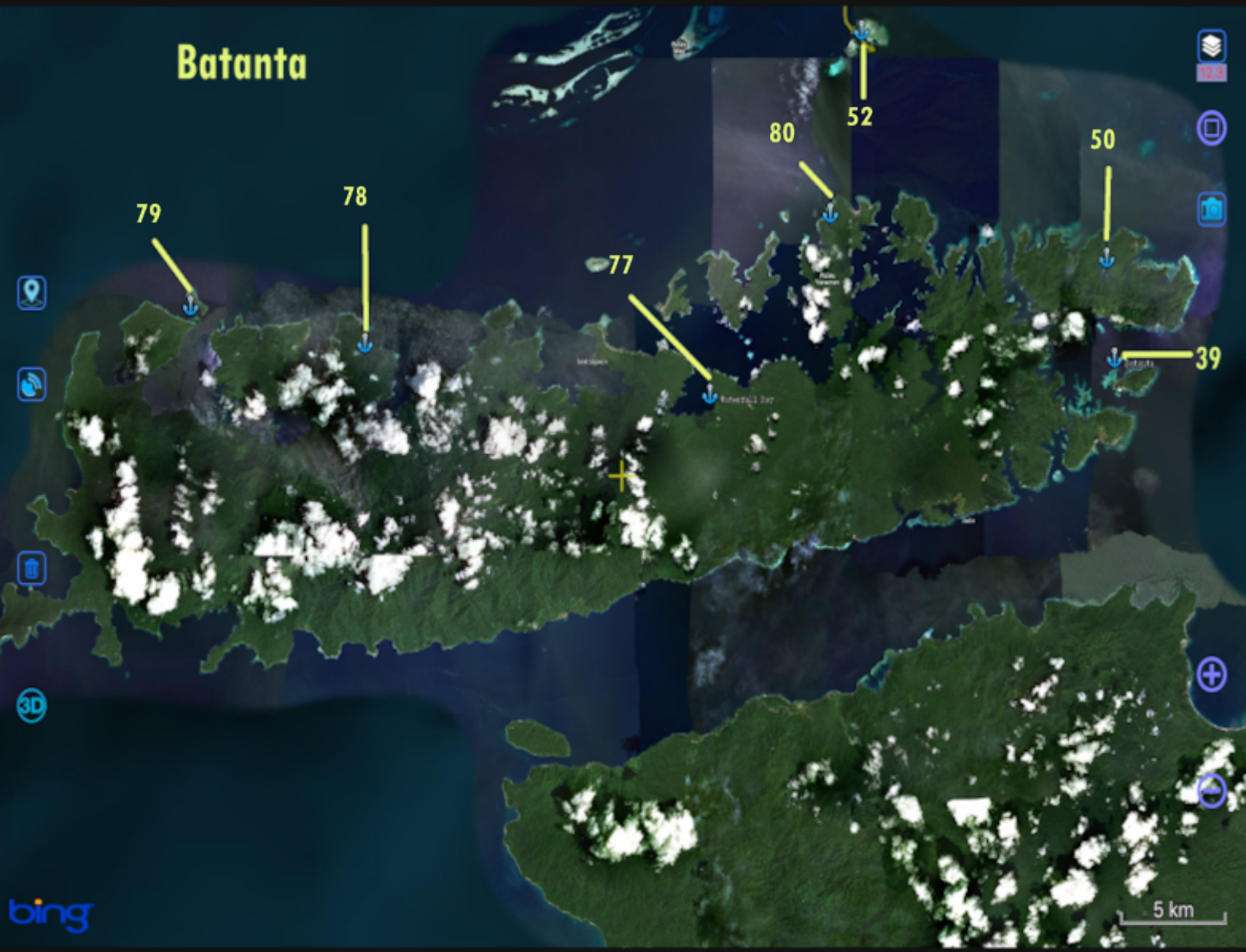
Raja Ampat -Misool-Triton Bay

To assist in identifying the relevant anchorage sites we have broken Raja Ampat into sections, Batanta, Central Raja Ampat, Northern Raja Ampat, Misool, To Triton Bay and Triton Bay. You will notice there are numbers against each site, these refer to the database field containing information to that anchorage.

This is not a comprehensive list of anchorages just the ones that we have visited. There are many more to be discovered.

This is not the anchorage they would like you to use and will come to ask you to move. On the chart you will see where we first anchored and then moved south a bit to a new location. The green lines are the correct ones. You are close to Manta Sandy and Manta Ridge the two main Manta areas. The wharf has excellent snorkelling and a good dive with lots of fish life.
